



ANTI-RAGGING / DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE

Aims of the committee-

- 1. To prevent and prohibit ragging in any form- ragging free campus
- 2. To create awareness among students, anti-ragging initiative
- 3. To establish and maintain **discipline**, **code of conduct**, **decorum**, **and behaviour** among the students (UG & PG) and interns
- 4. To maintain cordial relations in the campus

Objectives of the committee-

- 1. To **uphold the directives of Hon'ble Supreme court, UGC, NMC** Anti-ragging initiative
- 2. To maintain a **Ragging-free campus-Zero tolerance towards ragging**, creating awareness via education of staff, students-Display of posters, relay of movies, skits, street plays, Students oath etc
- 3. **Conduct of anti-ragging movement and orientation** during the foundation and orientation courses of MBBS, PG etc
- 4. Anti-Ragging week and day celebration 12 & 18 August 2024
- 5. Getting online and manual undertakings against ragging as per the UGC requirements from all students
- 6. **Conduct of periodic meetings** as and when the need arises to maintain the rules and regulations of the institute.
- 7. Anti-ragging initiative-
- College website, prospectus highlighted with the information on ragging, display of national toll-free number, anti-ragging committee members contact details displayed in prominent areas, including the prospectus, pamphlets and website.
- Orientation of students to curb the menace of ragging done during admission and periodically thereafter. Institutes rules and regulations informed verbally to the students and their parents done during the orientation courses- The Honourable VC, Dean & Principal, Convenor Anti-ragging committee & members, warden, counsellor, students seniors.
- A copy of Anti- ragging initiative with important numbers and links is also provided electronically and via hard copy during admission
- Anti-ragging Posters are displayed in prominent areas- hostel, college, library etc
- Continuous CCTV surveillance available on campus and vulnerable spots
- Online affidavit taken from all students from the year 2016 till date





- Any sort of undisciplined behaviour by students is appropriately dealt with by conducting a disciplinary meeting with the committee members and students and student representatives
- Periodic checking of hostel done by wardens and faculty of college-anti-ragging squad, staff living in quarters are conducted to curb ragging and maintain discipline.
- Files circular and minutes of previous meetings maintained by convener and coconvener

Responsibility- It shall be the duty of the Anti-Ragging Committee to ensure compliance with the provisions of these Regulations as well as the provisions of any law for the time being in force concerning ragging; and, to monitor and oversee the performance of the dedicated Anti-Ragging Squad in curbing the menace of ragging in the institution.

The Anti-Ragging Squad responsibility is to maintain vigil, oversight, conduct patrolling and shall remain dynamic, alert, and active always. Anti-Ragging Squad will conduct surprise visits in sensitive areas, including canteen, and other places that has the potential of prompting ragging and shall be empowered to inspect such places.

Evening rounds are conducted by faculty living within the campus to ensure safety and a vigil is maintained to oversee any untoward activities.

Protocol to be followed in case of incidence of ragging:

- ✓ A student experiences an episode of ragging
- A Formal written complaint to be filed with the Anti-ragging committee/Principal & Dean/The VC/ members of anti-ragging squads.
- ✓ Authenticity of the case will be examined by conducting a meeting with the committee
- ✓ Initiation of the enquiry process by the members deputed by the Hon'ble VC/ Principal Dean
- ✓ After a formal enquiry, the report will be forwarded to the Hon'ble VC/ Principal Dean
- ✓ Appropriate penalty actions will be recommended to the Hon'ble VC/ Principal Dean as per law.

ADMINISTRATIVE ACTION IN THE EVENT OF RAGGING-

The institution shall punish a student found guilty of ragging after following the





procedure and in the manner prescribed here in as under: The Anti-Ragging Committee of the Institution shall take an appropriate decision, in regard to punishment or otherwise, depending on the facts of each incident of ragging and nature and gravity of the incident of ragging established as per the recommendations of the Anti-Ragging Squad. The Anti-Ragging Committee may, depending on the nature and gravity of the guilt established by the Anti-Ragging Squad, award, to those found guilty, one or more of the following punishments, namely: 1. Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges. 2. Withholding / withdrawing scholarship/ fellowship and other benefits. 3. Debarring from appearing in any test/ examination or other evaluation process. 4. Withholding results. 5. Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc. 6. Suspension/ expulsion from the hostel.

- 7. Cancellation of admission.
- 8. Rustication from the institution for period ranging from one to four semesters.
- 9. Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specified period.
- 10. In cases where the persons committing or abetting the act of ragging are not

identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment.
